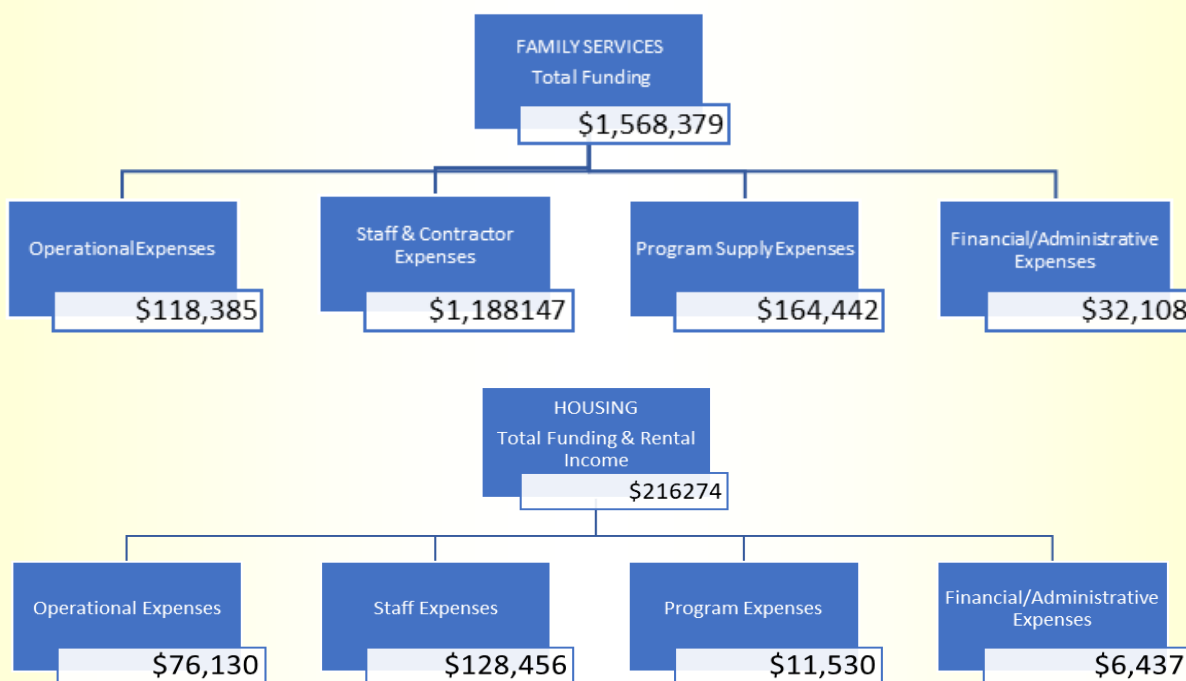

- In the summer of 2019, Boundary Family Services began accepting applications for the newly constructed Raven Place, a BC Housing affordable housing complex. Tenants began moving in to the building in November of 2019.
- From January to March 2020, Boundary Family Services operated the Safe Stay Shelter, an emergency cold weather shelter located at the old Greyhound bus depot on Donaldson Drive.
- The Boundary Better at Home Program began providing services to seniors. This includes volunteer visits, grocery shopping, light housework, and other helpful tasks, enabling seniors to stay in their own homes longer.
- The Farmer's Market Nutrition Coupon Program was expanded, providing over \$10,000 in vouchers to pregnant women and families with children under 6 years of age.
